### **Forming the Platform**

1. Commandant of the colleges recently sent a letter inviting organizations to present relevant issues for writing as part of the research thesis project.
2. Considerations in focusing and filtering the issues - convergence of topics that allow multidisciplinary practice; Not limited in classification and sources; Does not narrow down to a focused question.
3. The participants will receive the list of subjects attached here (not including the appendixes).
4. The references we received from external parties are fully presented in appendix A.
5. A list of topics to be addressed by the Command and Staff / Tactical Command Colleges' faculty is shown in appendix B.

### **Final Research Project – List of Subjects:**

1. The Challenges of learning and maintaining organizational relevance in a dynamic and changing environment.
2. Digital culture in organizations – barriers and strengths.
3. Smart cities and their influence on national security.
