- Today I came with a **good news.**
- The vaccine is **on his way** to Israel.
- Germany <u>ensure</u> Israel <u>will receive</u> Covid-19 vaccine

The EU has an agreement to procure vaccinations from eu medical company.

Germany says Israel is part of the EU for this deal.

The German government <u>has committed</u> to provide Israel Covid-19 vaccine <u>being</u> <u>developed</u> by UK-Swedish company (AZN).

if it is **found to be safe** and **effectiv**.

the Israeli Embassy in Germany <u>has declared</u>
The EU has signed an agreement with AZN company to reserve 400 million vaccinations.

according to the Israeli Embassy in Berlin, Germany <u>will insist that</u> Israel, <u>will be considered</u> part of the EU.

The <u>commitment was given</u> to Israeli Foreign Minister Gabi Ashkenazi and Israeli by German Foreign Minister and the German Health Minister .

However, it is unclear how quickly such large amounts of the vaccine, **being developed** can be delivered.

The Covid-19 vaccine is <u>currently in advanced</u> Phase III human trials.

In summary

- @ Germany sees Israel as part of Europe in terms of procuring the vaccine.
- @ This is not obvious.
- @ The deal is **part of Germany's 'special relationship'** with Israel and

its **commitment** to Israel's safety and security.
