MILITARY TRAINING AND EXERCISE PROGRAMME 2020-2024: OPEN TO PARTNERS AND NON-NATO ENTITIES PORTION

BACKGROUND

1. At Enclosure 1, HQ SACT submitted the Military Training and Exercise Programme (MTEP) Open to Partners (OTP) and Non-NATO Entities (NNEs) portion that allows NATO to offer relevant collective training events and exercises to Partners and to assist them in selecting those that best support their individual programmes.

AIM

2. To seek NAC approval for Partners and NNEs to participate in, or observe, NATO collective training events and exercises and their related planning activities as summarized in the OTP and NNE portion of the MTEP for 2020 – 2024.

CONSIDERATIONS

3. In line with Reference A, MC endorsement and NAC approval for Partners and NNEs to participate in, or observe, a NATO training event or exercise is required and summarized through submission of the OTP and NNE portion of the MTEP, which will occur annually and use the same five-year span as for Allies.

4. In the context of the Partnership Interoperability Initiative (Reference B) and the Connected Forces Initiative, the MTEP OTP and NNE portion becomes a planning tool that



provides visibility of the schedule and structure of NATO's exercise programme to Partners and NNEs, enabling their long-term planning.

5. The large number of military collective training events and exercises made available to Partners and NNEs cover a wide area of NATO training and exercise requirements. Partners and NNEs, in close coordination with NATO action authorities, should ensure that selection of NATO collective training events and exercises meets their own individual objectives with NATO as well as the objectives and priorities of NATO.

6. The MC recognises Partners' and NNEs' need to plan in advance their involvement in NATO Exercises, as well as to mobilize the required resources. Therefore, the MC considers that the scope of approval of the OTP and NNEs portion will span the same five year cycle as the MTEP does for Allies. Adaptations of the NATO training cycle relevant to Partners and NNEs, as well as changes with regard to Partner and NNEs eligibility, will be covered through the annual approval process of the MTEP OTP and NNEs portion¹.

7. If there is a perception of political sensitivity, Allies retain the right to request a case-by-case MC endorsement and NAC approval of the linkages or the Exercise Specifications, including Partner participation in NATO collective training events and exercises. In such a case, upon an Ally notification, ACT² will notify the MC, in a written form about the envisioned Partner and NNEs participation in, or observation of, those events, as soon as the details are known, to allow Allies' timely consideration. The MC will then review its approval to "Open to All" NATO Collective Training Events and Exercises. ACT² will provide updates to the MC on Partners and/or NNEs participation in, or observation of, events listed in MTEP-OTP 2020-2024 after the Main Planning Conference (MPC) of each exercise. The eMTEP³ must be continuously updated to ensure full and timely visibility to Allies regarding Partner participation in NATO collective training and exercises.

8. The MC considers that certain NATO collective training events and exercises require additional scrutiny, once details regarding the intended Partner or NNE involvement are identified. This includes:

a. Article 5-related exercises, which may have political, operational and, in some cases, legal implications; therefore, Partners and NNEs participation in, or observation of, such events is subject to MC endorsement and NAC approval. The extension of such participation in Article 5 exercises should not be assumed. Such participation should be considered on a case-by-case basis. In any case, the perception that Article 5 is also applicable to Partners and NNEs has to be strictly avoided.

b. Cyber Defence related exercises, where practical cooperation in the cyber domain is tailored to individual needs and circumstances of Partner Nations; therefore, Partners and NNEs participation in, or observation of, such events is

subject to MC endorsement and NAC approval (Reference C, Annex 1, Paragraph 31).

c. New exercises, not covered by the current MTEP OTP and NNEs list at Enclosure 1, which will require separate MC endorsement and NAC approval, once the request for a Partner or NNE involvement is submitted.

d. COALITION WARRIOR Interoperability eXploration, eXperimentation, eXamination, eXercise (CWIX) meets a broad spectrum of technical interoperability validation and verification requirements. Partner and NNE participation in and observation of CWIX is therefore subject to the provisions of the NATO CWIX Overarching Guidance.

e. In order to be eligible to participate in live exercises (LIVEX), Partners must either have forces participating in NATO-led operations or have forces declared in the Operational Capabilities Concept (OCC) Pool of Forces or the NATO Response Force. Prior to participating in NATO LIVEXs, Partner forces must undergo a Pre-Exercise Quality Threshold Evaluation process, tailored to the evaluation level achieved in OCC.

9. In order to avoid redundancy, the MC considers that additional approval processes for Partners already allowed to participate in NATO exercises should be avoided. In this respect, the MC considers that the following Partners groupings are granted full access to NATO collective training events and exercises (except Article 5 and Cyber Defence related):

a. Operational Partners formally accepted by the NAC, in accordance with the procedures at References D and E, may participate in, or observe, NATO collective training events and exercises related to the Operation they are contributing to (Reference A).

b. Partners and other non-NATO Nations that have been formally accepted to the NATO Response Force (NRF) by the NAC, in accordance with the agreed Framework for Partner Involvement in the NRF, are authorised full participation to the NRF training cycle, including all planning and preparation events and activities (Reference A).

c. Enhanced Opportunity Partners, which should be granted enhanced opportunities by the NAC in all collective training events, exercises (except Article 5 and Cyber Defence related), and associated planning activities, to include pre-design and scenario design phases (Reference B).

CONCLUSIONS

10. In line with Reference A, the MC endorses Partners and NNEs participation in, or observation of, NATO collective training events and exercises and their related planning activities, through the submission of the OTP and NNE portion of the MTEP for 2020 – 2024, listed at Enclosure 1.

11. For Exercises described at Paragraph 7, upon an Ally notification, ACT⁴ will notify the MC, in a written form, about the envisioned Partner and NNEs participation in, or observation of, those events, as soon as the details are known, to allow Allies' timely consideration. The MC will then review its approval to "Open to All" NATO Collective Training Events and Exercises. ACT⁴ will also provide updates to the MC on Partners and/or NNEs participation in, or observation of, events listed in MTEP-OTP 2020-2024 after the MPC of each exercise.
12. The MC concludes that Partners' involvement in Exercises described at Paragraph 8 will require additional scrutiny, once the details regarding the intended Partner or NNE involvement are known.
13. In line with Paragraph 9, the MC endorses that Enhanced Opportunity Partners are granted full access⁵ to related NATO collective training events and exercises (except Article 5 and Cyber Defence related).
14. The MC concurs with ACT's General Guidelines and the technicalities defined within the Annex A to the Enclosure, which will need to be carefully considered before any Partners' involvement in NATO exercises.

RECOMMENDATIONS

15. The MC recommends that the Council:
 - a. Approves Partners' and NNEs' participation in, or observation of, NATO collective training events and exercises, and the related planning activities, as concluded in Paragraph 10.
 - b. Notes that Partners' involvement in the collective training events and exercises described at Paragraph 7 require MC notification as concluded in Paragraph 11.
 - c. Notes that Partners' and NNEs' involvement in Article 5 and Cyber Defence related NATO collective training events and exercises require additional scrutiny, once the details regarding the intended Partner or NNE involvement are identified, as concluded in Paragraph 12.
 - d. Approves that the participation in, or observation of, NATO collective training events and exercises (except Article 5, Cyber Defence related) by the Enhanced Opportunity Partners, is fully granted, as concluded in Paragraph 13.



1. In accordance with Reference A, the Military Training and Exercise Programme (MTEP) 2020-2024 Open to Partners and Non-NATO Entities (OTP & NNE) portion (Reference B) was forwarded for endorsement by the Military Committee and approval by the North Atlantic Council. Although Reference A was signed on 19 June 19, due to an error in the registry distribution system the document was not delivered to the IMS until 08 October 19.

2. Per Reference C, a revised and updated Annex A to the MTEP OTP & NNE Portion 2020-2024 is submitted, incorporating comments provided by the Nations regarding Partner and Non-NATO Entities participation in NATO Exercises.

3. Annex A reflects an update to References B and D based on ongoing changes to the exercise programme maintained within the electronic Military Training and Exercise Programme (eMTEP), which is routinely updated by NATO Command and NATO Force Structure Training and Exercise representatives. The most current information within eMTEP is available at <https://emtep.exonaut.com>.

MTEP 2020-2024: OTP & NNE Portion

Definitions:

Allies. Within this document, "Allies" refers to NATO member states.

Partners. Within this document, "partners" refers to Partnership for Peace (PfP except Russia), Mediterranean Dialogue (MD), and Istanbul Cooperation Initiative (ICI) countries, as well as those partners across the globe with a partnership programme with NATO, unless otherwise stated (Ref MC 458/3, footnote 1).

Non-NATO Entities (NNE). Within this document, NNE includes International Organisations (IO), Governmental Organisations (GO) of non-NATO nations, Non-Governmental Organisations (NGO), Non-NATO Multinational forces, Host Nations (when the Host Nation is not a NATO nation), contractors on operations, exercises and transformational activities, and Non-NATO countries that do not meet the "partners" criteria (Ref MC 458/3, footnote 3).

Operational Partners. Within this document, an "operational partner" is defined as a country that contributes forces/capabilities to a NATO-led operation, or supports it in other ways that the Council formally accepts as a contribution, based on political-military advice (PO(2011)0141, Paragraph 4).

Mission Relevant NNEs. Within this document, "Mission Relevant NNEs" defines all NNEs that are operating in support of a NATO-led operation, in its Area of Interest or support it in other ways consistent with the principles of Alliance contribution to a Comprehensive Approach¹. Further, they are assessed by the exercise planners as relevant for exposing the training audiences to the most likely International Community environment to be encountered in a real Area of Operations.

General guidelines:

1. Partner and NNE participation in, or observation of, NATO Education, Training, Exercises, and Evaluation (ETEE) activities is subject to Military Committee (MC) and/or North Atlantic Council (NAC) endorsement / approval process as outlined in the ETEE Policy. With the aim of allowing sufficient time for proper planning and participation, the involvement of Partners and NNEs is approved in principle through the Military Training and Exercise Programme (MTEP). Headquarters, Supreme Allied

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Commander Transformation (HQ SACT) is responsible for obtaining NAC approval of Partner nations and NNE participation in or observation of NATO exercises.

2. In order to foster and support interoperability, the exercises listed in this document will be as open as possible to Partners and NNEs. Emphasis will be given to encourage broader and more frequent participation in NATO exercises for Interoperability Platform (IP) members. Given the MTEP focus on collective training of the NATO Command Structure and NATO Force Structure (NCS/NFS), each exercise open to Partners and NNEs should be scrutinized on their merits to deliver the desired training effects and to complement the individual education and training acquired nationally or by utilization of assets described in paragraph 18 of NATO ETEE Policy. Strategic Commands (SC) will take the necessary steps to increase Partner and NNE awareness of NATO exercises in order to facilitate increased participation tailored to the Partners' needs.
3. In order to allow Partners and NNEs ample time to allocate funds effectively towards their participation in and/or observation of NATO exercises, the exercises open to Partners and NNE use the same five-year span as the MTEP. Given the annual approval of the Partner and NNE portion of the MTEP, exercises open to Partners and NNEs which have been previously approved will again be subject to the approval process if there have been changes with regard to Partner and NNE eligibility from previous approval cycles.
4. For the participation of ANY Partner in ANY NATO Live Exercise (LIVEX), that Nation must currently either have forces participating in NATO-led operations or have forces declared in the Operational Capabilities Concept (OCC) Pool of Forces or the NATO Response Force (NRF). Exceptions to this policy require NAC approval. Prior to participating in NATO LIVEXs, partner forces must undergo a Pre-Exercise Quality Threshold Evaluation (PETE)
5. Contributing Partners to a specific NRF rotation have complete access to all planning activities of the associated NRF-related exercises (including Article 5 related exercises upon explicit MC endorsement and NAC approval) and will be included in the compilation and planning of the MTEP as it relates to these exercises.
6. In order to encourage, facilitate, and sustain continued future contributions to the Alliance, Partners which are granted enhanced opportunities by the NAC in accordance with the Partnership Interoperability Initiative (PII), are approved for participation in all exercises open to Partners (except Article 5 and Cyber related exercises) and their associated events, including early-stage planning. This takes precedence over the guiding principles for Partner and NNE eligibility listed in paragraph 7 below.
7. Coalition Warrior Interoperability eXploration, eXperimentation, eXamination, eXercise (CWIX) meets a broad spectrum of technical interoperability validation and verification requirements. Partner and NNE participation in and observation of CWIX is therefore subject to meeting the minimum entry requirements, in accordance with the NATO CWIX Overarching Guidance.
