Joe Riley NSC Biography

Dr. Joe Riley currently serves as the Director for Oceania & Indo-Pacific Security on the National Security Council at the White House. Joe is detailed to the NSC from the Department of Defense, where he serves as an infantry officer in the U.S. Army. Previous overseas service includes Afghanistan, Ukraine, China, Thailand, the Republic of Korea, and the United Kingdom. Joe received his MPhil and DPhil in International Relations from the University of Oxford on a Rhodes Scholarship. His dissertation focused on U.S. – China trade relations in the Post-Cold War Era. He adapted this manuscript into a book draft, *The Great Gamble: Washington's Ill-Fated Attempt to Reform Beijing,* which is currently under review for publication. Prior to Oxford, Joe worked on China issues with the Senate Foreign Relations Committee and the National Ground Intelligence Center. He completed his undergraduate work in International Relations and Chinese Language at the University of Virginia. He and his wife, Dr. Rachel Riley, live in Washington D.C.
