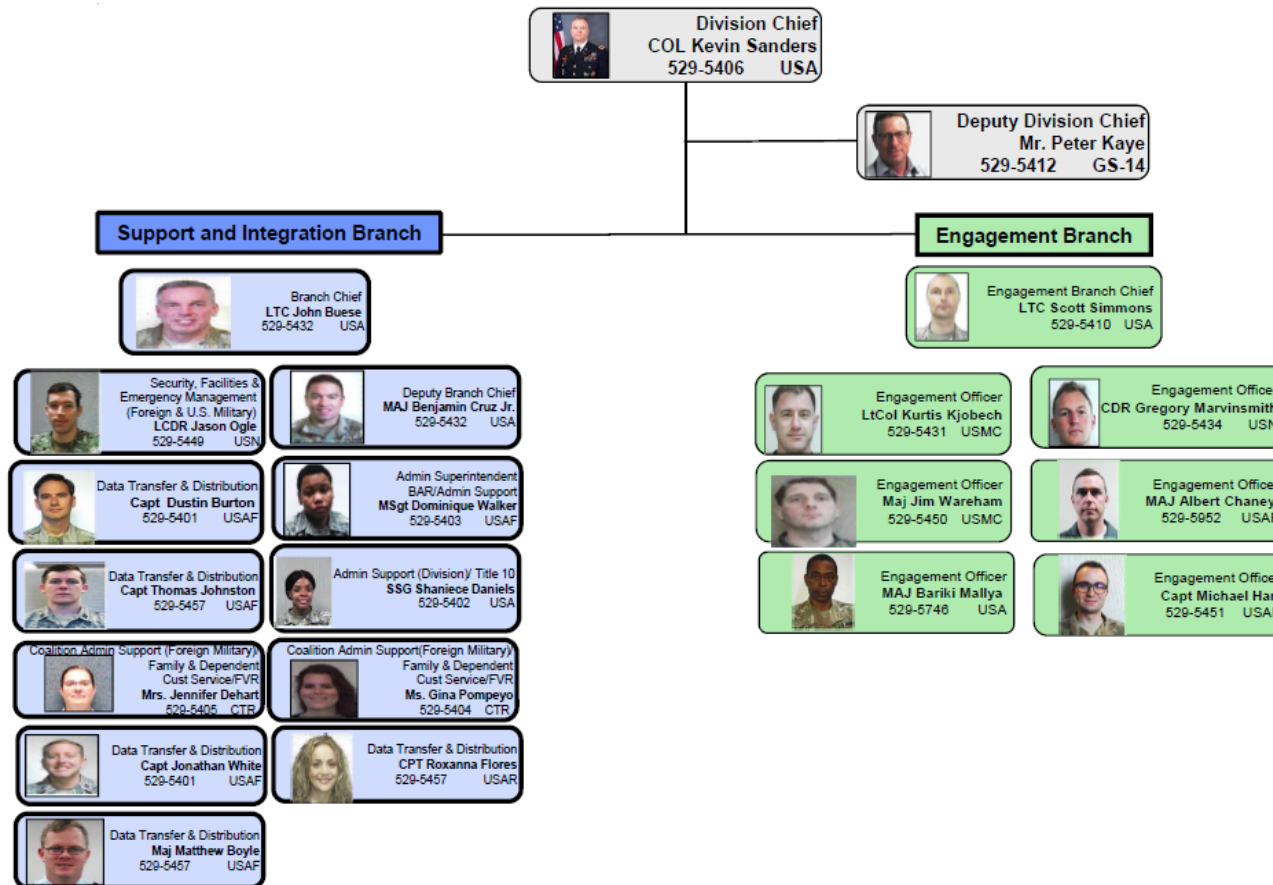

Mission/Function/Priorities

Mission

CCC supports the strategic objectives of the Commander by serving as the primary advocate for Foreign Liaison Officers / Senior National Representatives (FLOs/SNRs) of the partner nations assigned to Tampa. Additionally, the CCC provides technical and administrative support to all foreign officers at the Command, regardless of their duty assignment (i.e. NREOs)

Key Functions

Support & Integration – Invitational Travel Orders, Foreign Visit Requests, Base Access Requests, ID Cards, Data Transfer Operations, Information Sharing, Facilities Management, Security, Title 10, Coalition In/Out-processing, CCC Orientation, Social Engagements (i.e. International Night)

Engagement – SNR advocacy, Staff Integration, KLEs, SNR injects and perspectives, Distinguished Visitors, Force Generation (SNR coordination), SNR RFIs, Coalition Operational Needs Statements (CONS), FLO MOAs, Conference Support

Challenges

- ✓ High Turnover, More Challenging to Develop Relationships
- ✓ Seniority of Engagement Officers vs Seniority of SNRs
- ✓ Arranging Cultural Events with no FAO background

Deliverables

- ✓ DV Itineraries, TPs, & Readouts (as required)
- ✓ Signed MOAs/MOUs
- ✓ Country Letters
- ✓ SNR Injects = Talking Points / RFI Responses
- ✓ CONS



Engagement Key Tasks(U)

DV Visits

- Typically handle all Coalition non-AOR DV (O7+) visits to the command, and many large groups that include Coalition
- Set up itinerary, draft TPs, task out TMT, shape brief agenda, base access, FVRs, Readouts
- Within last 6 months, have handled NLD CHOD, FIN CHOD, HUN CHOD, SWE AMB, AFG AMB, FRME CJOs, and numerous others

AOR Engagement

- AOR Tea (all AOR SNRs, every two weeks)
- Regular Office Drive-visits (priority)
- Assisting AOR Delegations

SNR Onboarding

- Make hotel arrangements, set up CAC apt
- Meet at airport, drive to lodging
- Drive them around to CAC apt, look at lodging, etc
- Assist with getting U.S. bank account, cell phone, finding a used car, getting it registered at DMV, obtaining Florida Driver's license

SNR Engagement/Advocacy

- Country Letters
- CoS Talking Points
- J3 Sourcing Support
- Country RFIs
- Staff Connections (Bridge Building)
- KLEs
- Information Sharing



Coalition Operational Needs Statement (CONS) Overview (U)

FY15 National Defense Authorization Act, Section 1207¹

- Loan equipment for personnel protection/survivability to coalition partners which are:
 - Participating in coalition contingency operation w/ U.S.
 - Participating in coalition operation w/ U.S. under UN charter or other international agreement
 - Training forces in connection w/ deployment of proceeding scenarios above
- Authority
 - Requires SecDef approval and DoS concurrence²
 - Historically, SecDec delegates approval for most 1207 equipment categories to COCOMs
 - No FY20 delegation memo yet received, so ALL CONS are being routed to OSD / Joint Staff
- Process
 - USFOR-A / NSOCC-A submits request and justification to loan to coalition partner
 - CENTCOM Drafts "1207" Request memo through the DCDR to the Joint Staff
- CCC Involvement
 - POC for USFOR-A & NSOCC-A here at CENTCOM
 - Overall Program Management under guidance from CCJ4
 - Manage process from OCONUS request through J3, J4, JA, J6 up through COS/DCOM/SJS

Note 2: DOS issued blanket concurrence for most coalition partners via 2015 memo.



Wrap Up

- **Foreign Liaison Officer Memorandums of Agreement**
 - 12 of 55 Concluded, Priority on T10 Partners and AOR Countries
- **T10 Sec 312 Funding**
 - 30 May 2020 ends 312 funding to non AOR countries (ARM, UKR, MNG)
 - ETP due to COVID extends this through 15 August, ETP Request to 15 November at JS
 - Impacted SNRs expected to depart when travel is permissible
- **Coalition Operational Needs Statements T10 Sec 1207**
 - Support USFOR-A/ORS
 - Approved by DCDR
