The School also has been known as the U.S. Naval Postgraduate School, Postgraduate School, and as the Postgraduate Department of the U.S. Naval Academy. Prior to 1952 it was located in Annapolis, Maryland.

The unit of credit is the quarter hour. Each quarter hour equals one period of prepared class work (or two periods of laboratory work) per week per term of either 10 weeks or 12 weeks. Periods are 50 minutes in length. The amount of work for each course is shown as "R" for recitation and "L" for laboratory. Both total credit and graduate credit is shown. Both graduate and total quality point averages are shown. Quality point averages are computed separately for each curriculum in which a student is enrolled.
