"Legal Dimensions of Contemporary and Future Use of Force"

28 to 30 October 2019

Practical information

1. Venue

The course will take place from Monday, 28 to Wednesday, 30 October 2019 at the GCSP:

The course starts every day at 09:00 - Please be on time.

Upon arrival at the GCSP, you will be provided a personal badge at the reception; please make sure to carry this badge with you at all times when at the Maison de la Paix / GCSP. We would also like to remind you that this badge needs to be returned to GCSP on the last day of the course.

2. Meals

The GCSP hosts coffee breaks during the course. In the evening of Monday, 28th an official dinner has been organised and will be held at the restaurant's "Café Papon" in the Old Town of Geneva.

For **lunch**, all participants have access to the cafeteria of the *Maison de la Paix* (situated in Petal 2 on the 3rd floor). Scholarship participants will get vouchers for all lunches worth a maximum of CHF 20.00. If you consume less, GCSP will not be charged for the difference. If you consume more, you will be charged personally.

3. Transportation

a) Transport from and to the airport

In the airport, in the same room as the baggage claim/carousel is a machine labelled- 'Free Ticket' or 'Billet Gratuit'. Tickets are valid for 80 minutes on the entire Geneva public transportation network including trains, tramways and buses. Free tickets are only available from the machine before exiting through the customs check doors. Outside customs, tickets can be purchased at automatic ticket machines for CHF 3.50 or € 2.80 (credit cards, Swiss Francs and Euros accepted with change given on machines with touch screens; those without only take coins (CHF and EUR) and do not give change.) Once you have checked into your hotel, ask for a free transit card (the equivalent of a ticket) entitling you to the use of public transit around the city for the duration of your stay at the hotel.





b) Transportation within Geneva

The GCSP can be accessed by public transportation from the main Geneva railway station "Gare Cornavin". Tram 15 (to "Nations") will take you from the station to the stop "Maison de la paix" in about five minutes. The Building Maison de la paix is about two minutes' walk from the tram stop, just across the railway bridge. Trams run every five minutes during the day.

4. Visa Requests

It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure that she/he is in possession of all necessary visa and transit visa.

5. Language

The course is conducted entirely in English. Translation is not provided.

6. Dress code

Business attire (no uniforms).

7. Security

To enter the building, we ask you to indicate your name at the reception of the GCSP. The receptionist may ask you for an identity card or passport. We will then provide you with a visitor's badge. The GCSP visitor's badge must be returned to us before your departure from the Centre.

8. Health insurance

The GCSP does not cover any health care expenses. All participants of GCSP activities are responsible for ensuring that they are in possession of valid and adequate insurance (accident, repatriation, liability and health). If not, individuals must have the written proof that their employers will cover any such expenses.

9. Budget and Finance

The local currency in Switzerland is the Swiss Franc (CHF). Although Euro is widely accepted, we recommend all participants to carry CHF with them.


