- **Mr. Thanassis Mavridis** – Publisher, Editor “Fileleftheros” newspaper, [liberal.gr](http://liberal.gr), among the most important newspapers and websites in Greece. He is a very prominent commentator on political/economic issues and has close ties to the current New Democracy Government in Greece.
- **Constantine Papadopoulos**

Constantine Papadopoulos began his professional life as a career diplomat. For many years he specialized in EU affairs, and was directly involved, inter alia, in the negotiations that led to the EU's 4th enlargement (1995) and the signing of the Treaty of Amsterdam (1997). He then spent a year at Harvard University as a Fellow of the Weatherhead Center for International Affairs, conducting research and lecturing. He subsequently moved to the banking industry and Eurobank EFG where he worked for 13 years as Advisor on European and Economic Affairs. In 2010-2012 he was Secretary-General for International Economic Relations & Development Cooperation at the Hellenic Ministry of Foreign Affairs in charge, inter alia, of Greece's economic relations with the rest of the world, as well as trade and investment promotion. Dr. Papadopoulos has published scholarly papers on European integration, EMU and Greek-Turkish relations, among others at Oxford and Harvard. As of Fall semester 2015, he is teaching 'Business in the European Union', 'International Business' and 'Business Negotiation' at the School of Business as a part-time faculty member.

## **Group B**

- **Dr. Domna Michailidou Deputy Minister of Labour and Social Affairs**, responsible for social welfare and social solidarity of the Hellenic Republic. Dr. Domna Michailidou is an academic economist working on economic development, financial crises and public finances. She was previously Reforms' Adviser to the Leader of New Democracy Party in Greece, where she advised Kyriakos Mitsotakis on a series of issues related to structural reforms, macroeconomic growth and financial markets. Since 2014, Dr Michailidou was also Adjunct Lecturer in the Centre of Development Studies, University of Cambridge where she has been teaching topics related to finance and development, private and public debt and government regulation. She has worked for the OECD in Paris and Athens as an economist and a competition expert. Dr Michailidou has also taught for several years at the Judge Business School University of Cambridge and UCL's School of Public Policy. She has advised governmental and non-governmental institutions such as the UNDP, the FAO, the British Council, the Ministry of Health in Iran et al.. Her latest book, *The Inexorable Evolution of Financialization: Financial Crises in Emerging Markets*, was published by Palgrave MacMillan. Her work has also appeared in academic journals, institutional reports and the popular press. She holds an MPhil and a PhD on Financial and Development Economics from the University of Cambridge.
- **Mr. Vasilis Kostoulas** - Editor in Chief "Naftemporiki" newspaper, [naftemporiki.gr](http://naftemporiki.gr). Naftemporiki is the oldest and one of the most respected economic newspapers in Greece. Vasilis has an excellent knowledge of Greek economic and political affairs.
- **George Pagoulatos**  
George Pagoulatos is Professor of European Politics and Economy at the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB), and Visiting Professor at the College of Europe in Bruges. He is the Vice-President of the Athens-based Hellenic Foundation for European and Foreign Policy (ELIAMEP) and sits on the Governing Board of the Brussels-based European Policy Centre (EPC).  
He has extensive experience in providing macro-advisory and analysis to corporates and organizations. He is a frequent keynote speaker in international conferences and corporate events, and has been widely interviewed and quoted in the international media regarding Greek and EU political economy and politics. Author of several books and many articles, he is a regular columnist in the Sunday edition of the main Greek centrist newspaper Kathimerini since 2007. In 2011-12 he served as senior advisor and director of strategy at the PM Office under Greece's two non-political prime ministers. Pagoulatos holds a Law degree from the University of Athens, M.Sc. and D.Phil. in Politics from the University of Oxford, where he was a Rhodes scholar. His research and publications focus on the EMU and the European Union, Greek and Southern European political economy, economic governance, the political economy of banking and finance, the political economy of reform. He has given lectures at several universities including Oxford, LSE, Harvard, Yale, NYU, and Princeton, where he was a postdoctoral fellow. He is a member of the Advisory Board of Social Europe, and was a member of the High

Council of the European University Institute (EUI) in Florence (2010-13), and President of ECSA-Greece (2013-14).

His monograph *Greece's New Political Economy: State, Finance and Growth from Postwar to EMU* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2003) won the Academy of Athens award for best book in economics. He was short-listed for the Rudolf Wildenmann "best paper" prize of the European Consortium of Political Research. He has been part of several EC-funded networks of excellence, and the research project DOSEI (on the EU Constitution building process), nominated for the European Commission's 2006 Descartes prize for scientific excellence.

- **Mr Antonis Diamataris, Deputy Foreign Minister for Diaspora Greeks**

Born and raised on the island of Limnos, Greece.

He immigrated to the United States with his family, where he studied Economics at Queens College of New York and Business Administration (MBA) at Columbia University.

Publisher and editor of *Ethnikos Kyryx* (National Herald) and *The National Herald*, Greece largest Diaspora paper and news website in the US.

*Ethnikos Kyryx* was founded in 1915, and is the only daily newspaper in the Greek language outside of Greece and Cyprus.

He founded the English-language weekly newspaper *National Herald* in 1997.

Married with two children.

Appointed as Deputy Foreign Minister for Diaspora Greeks following national elections in July 2019.

Visited Israel on 4 October 2019 (Jerusalem and Tel Aviv) where he met with the Patriarch of Jerusalem, Mr. Theophilos III, the head of the Jewish Agency for Israel, Yitzhak Herzog and representatives of the Association of Greek Holocaust Survivors. Also visited the Yad Vashem World Holocaust Remembrance Center.

Prior to his visit, he met in Athens with the Palestinian Ambassador, Marwan Toubassi.

In the meeting, Mr. Diamataris referred "to the great sensitivity Greece has always shown on the Palestinian issue and to the relations of mutual appreciation, friendship and trust" between the Greek and Palestinian peoples.

He has been in the past a member of the Ministry of Defense's Crisis Management Committee, a researcher at the Institute of International Relations, the Institute for Defense Analysis, the Institute for Mediterranean Studies and the Institute for International Economic Relations.
