Day 1: Thursday

- Arriving at Ben Gurion airport
- You will be welcomed by our guide

- Drive to Jerusalem
- Prayer at Hutba at the Al Aqsa Mosque
- Guided tour of the Haram esh-Sharif learning about its historical and about the Dome of the Rock. "Whose precincts we did bless" – Al Qur'an el Kareem, Sura 17, verse 1.
- Visit the underground Mosque below the Al Aqsa, just newly opened to the public.
- Continue along the colorful Shuk (bazaar) to the Church of the Resurrection of Jesus. Where the Khalif Omar met the Bishop Sophronius and prayed outside the church and commemorating this event.
- Walk via the Jewish Quarter to observe the archaeological excavations such as the Roman Cardo, King David's Tomb – a place for Muslims, Jews and Christians.
- We end the day at the Kotel (the Western Wall)
- Overnight and Dinner Jerusalem

#### Day 2: Friday

- Enjoy breakfast at hotel
- We will begin our day with the different Mosques on top of the Mt of Olives.
- Enjoy the breathtaking view and panoramic view of Jerusalem.
- This is a Friday and we will give time for all to pray at Al Aqsa Mosque.
- Walk down to the marble- memorial of Mujir-e-Din al Hanbaly, a medieval philosopher, located just above the Tomb of Sitt Mariam (Mary) in the Garden of Gethsemane.
- Drive to visit Maqam e-Nebi Samuel, Tomb of the Prophet Samuel, whom is holy for all 3 main monotheistic religions.
- From this site there is a great view to Jerusalem and towards the Mediterranean Sea.
- If time permits, we end the day with a short hike in Masrek Nature Reserve, visiting the Tomb of Salman el Farsi, who was the personal Barber of the Prophet Mohammed. Peace shall be upon him due to the holiness of the site, the goats were kept off it, enabling some giant pine -trees to grow here.
- Overnight and Dinner Jerusalem

#### Day 3: Saturday

- Enjoy breakfast at hotel
- Drive to Acco
- Enter the old city via the thick walls that symbolize the Islamic victory over the "Emperor" – Napoleon Bonaparte
- We visit the very well-preserved "Knights Halls" which were buried under the Muslim city
- Visit Turkish Hammam
- Visit to glorious Al Jazzar mosque and time for prayer. This mosque became a symbol of the city of Acco.
- The mosque is also famous for keeping a piece of hair of the Prophet's beard!

- Continue to Jaffa
- Drive back to Jerusalem for overnight and dinner

#### Day 4: Sunday

- Breakfast at hotel
- Checkout of hotel
- Drive to Hebron also named Al Khalil after the prophet Ibrahim.
- Visit Ibrahimi Mosque (Haram el Khalil)
- Visit the ancestors tomb (Hamechpela)
- Transfer to airport
- Departure to Turkey
