



Upon arrival in Israel, international travelers must make the following statements to be permitted 14-day isolation in a dwelling of choice, instead of state-sponsored motel isolation:

- They have the conditions to enter strict home isolation in full compliance with the home isolation guidance at home or a
  dwelling completely separated from other tenants for the entire duration.
- They commit to not using public transportation to travel to the dwelling, except a single-passenger taxi, provided they sit in the back of the taxi with windows open (if family members arrive together and they all live in the same household, they may travel together as long as everyone sits in the back).
- 3. They are fully aware of the fact that the Israel Police closely monitor those required to stay in home isolation for the entire duration, and if they are found to violate the above-mentioned requirements, the police may force them to move to statesanctioned isolation (motel) for the remainder of the required duration and incur a NIS 5000 fine.
- If it turns out that the stated dwelling is not suitable for isolation, the District or HMO Physician may force them to move to state-sanctioned isolation (motel) for the remainder of the required duration.
